MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 16 APRIL 2015 IN BLAXTON VILLAGE HALL AT 19:45 AFTER THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

4) PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Four members of the public attended the meeting. During the Annual Parish Meeting issues had been raised about overhanging hedges, litter, traffic volume, vehicle turning and passing on Park Lane. It had been agreed that the concerns should be discussed under this item.

Concerns about litter and overhanging hedges were dealt with under Minute 8(c) below.

Members of the public were especially concerned about the absence of a passing point increased traffic volume and speed, the absence of a turning facility, turning difficulties for emergency services and heavy goods vehicles. Instances of difficulties for vehicle drivers including three vans reversing the length of the Lane at the same time recently were recounted. Residents felt that there was real danger of injury to Lane users and damage to property if action was not taken to improve the safety of the Park Lane for users.

Condition (9) of Planning Decision Notice 13/00548/FUL was referred and reads:-

The vehicle turning space as shown on the approved plans shall be constructed before the development is brought into use and shall thereafter be maintained as such.

REASON

To avoid the necessity of vehicles reversing on to or from the highway and creating a highway hazard.

It was the contention of members of the public that the highway had been extended to pass 62 Lark Lane to the new building and that the turning area should be available for public access and that the denial of access represented a breach of the planning condition.

Residents were thanked for their comments.

The Chair reported that three signs had been installed on Park Lane by a DMBC Officer.

b) Park Lane Issues – lighting, passing point, turning area, speed – Resolution 4

There was extensive public input on this issue, especially relating to vehicle turning and passing. The Chair and the Clerk explained that the Council had raised concerns about these issues with DMBC some time ago. A recent response from DMBC Highways confirmed that they were unable to take any actions in respect of vehicle turning or a passing point. DMBC Planning Enforcement had advised that there was no action which could be enforced to permit vehicle turning at 62 Park Lane under Planning Decision Notice 13/00548/FUL.

However, the Parish Council was persuaded that action needed to be taken to improve safety on Park Lane and that doubt existed about the right of public access to the turning area at the new bungalow built within the grounds of 62 Park Lane since this appeared to constitute an extension of the public highway.

RESOLVED (3)

That the Clerk be requested to raise the issues of vehicle turning, passing and safety again with DMBC and request a site meeting with DMBC representatives to discuss the concerns with Parish Council and resident representatives.

c) Park Lane – Litter and Hedge Maintenance

It was reported that a resident had contacted the Council and asked if it would be possible to remind residents about the need to maintain hedges along Park Lane and appeal to them to keep the Lane litter free outside their property. The Clerk reported that DMBC had been asked for advice about the duty of residents to maintain boundary fences so as not to obstruct the highway.

RESOLVED (4)

That it be noted that the Chair and Clerk had an appointment to meet a DMBC Officer on 20 April 2015 to inspect the area and discuss how to resolve the problems.
