PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019**

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

NOTICE is hereby given that Doncaster Borough Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 because works are being or proposed to be executed on or near the roads and the effect will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in those lengths of Wroot Road/Nan Simpson Bank at Finningley in the Doncaster Metropolitan District as described in the Schedule to this notice on the dates and times referred to in the said Schedule

Reason for closure: To ensure the safety of the public and the workforce whilst works to repair and surface dress the carriageways including subsequent relining are undertaken.

NOTICE is also given that the alternative route for vehicles affected by the Order is via Idle Bank, West End, Candy Bank, Nan Sampson Bank, Sandersons Bank, Bank End Road, Thorn Bank, Field Lane, High Street, Wroot Road. Access will be maintained at all times for emergency services attending a call.

The Proposed Order will continue in force up to and including the 31st day of August 2019 or until the works which it is proposed to carry out in or near the said roads have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

SCHEDULE

Location

- 1) Wroot Road, Finningley from its junction with Bank End Road to its junction with Nine Scores Lane
- 2) Nan Sampson Bank, Finningley from its junction with Nine Scores Lane to 630m past Levels Lane at the boundary with North Lincolnshire Council

Dates and Times

All closures to take place commencing on or after Wednesday 1st May 2019 up to and including Saturday 31st August 2019. The roads will be closed on up to 5 separate occasions, with each occasion lasting no longer than 3 consecutive days. This process is weather dependant and as such exact dates for each location cannot be given
