



## **NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS, POLLING PLACES AND POLLING STATIONS**

1. In accordance with the Representation of the People Act 1983, I hereby give notice that Doncaster Council is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places in the borough.
2. The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the Parliamentary constituencies of Doncaster Central, Doncaster North and Don Valley is responsible for the polling stations, which are the rooms within polling places where the poll actually takes place. As part of the Review, the (Acting) Returning Officer must formally comment on the existing polling stations and those representations will be published on the Council's website and be available for inspection at the Civic Office, Waterdale, Doncaster DN1 3BU.
3. The Council welcomes views or comments from electors and any persons or bodies with expertise in access to premises or facilities for persons with any type of disability. Local political parties and Ward Councillors will also be consulted. Please send us your comments and representations on any aspect of polling districts, or polling places currently used, together with any suggestions for alternative polling places within the borough.
4. Maps and information relating to the present polling arrangements are available for inspection at Electoral Services, Floor 2 Civic Office, Waterdale, Doncaster DN1 3BU and on the Council's website at:

Comments or representations should be made in writing to Electoral Services, Doncaster Council, Floor 2 Civic Office, Waterdale, Doncaster DN1 3BU, or by e-mail to [electoralservices@doncaster.gov.uk](mailto:electoralservices@doncaster.gov.uk) by Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Where possible, people making representations should suggest alternative places that may be used as polling places.
6. The results of the review will be published by the Council in November 2019 and will be available for inspection on the council's website and the above mentioned office. Persons or groups making submissions need to be aware that, upon completion of the review, all correspondence/representations received must by law, also be published.
